

BREAST COMMITTEE APPLICATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS AND COMMITTEE DESCRIPTION

The application package will consist of the completed application form, an NIH-type biosketch limited to 4 pages identifying salient information, appointments, publications, or a copy of your CV and all other support, and a brief 1 page cover letter stating the reasons why the applicant wishes to join the committee, what contributions he/she expects to make to the group, and outlining relevant past contributions and accomplishments. The deadline for submission of the application is May 31, 2018.

Applications for Breast Committee and Sub-committee membership will be reviewed by the current committee chairs and vice-chairs, and appointments will be announced prior to the NRG meeting in July 2018. Length of membership will be three years starting in January 2019. Committee members are expected to attend the NRG Semi-annual meetings but funds for transportation are not available.

NRG Breast Committees consist of the following:

FULL COMMITTEE:

This is the large group of investigators that traditionally meets on Saturday mornings at the NRG meeting, to discuss concepts approved by the Breast Working Committee, to receive updated information on open clinical trials and to generate relevant discussion from the broadest group of clinical investigators to advance the goals of the group.

WORKING GROUP:

The 30-40 members of this group are tasked with developing and defining the research agenda for breast cancer, from concept generation to final protocol development and implementation. The Working Group also oversees the conduct of the open and active trials. Members will be selected from Senior Investigators, Protocol Chairs, Sub-committee Chairs and promising junior investigators. A breast pathologist and breast radiologist are included in this committee.

SUB COMMITTEES:

These committees are smaller, with membership consisting of 10-15 investigators with a special interest in the focus of the sub-committee. Each sub-committee will be charged with identifying early concepts for potential future clinical trials, and bringing innovative ideas to the Working Group through the sub-committee chairs. These sub-committees include: (1) Local Regional Issues Sub-committee; (2) Translational Research Sub-committee; and (3) Rare or Genetically Linked Sub-committee.
